

Conversation board game

Grade: GESE Grade 6 (CEFR B1.2)

Time: 20 minutes

Exam task focus:

- ▶ To practise talking about the various Conversation phase subject areas and related Language Functions

Resources:

- ▶ One board game handout (see below) per group of three or four students. Printed on A4 or A3 paper (coloured paper if possible)
- ▶ Dice, and counters if possible.

Description of the activity

1. Tell students they're going to play a board game to practise the Conversation phase subject areas and Language Functions of GESE Grade 6.
2. Put them in groups of three or four students and give each group a board game handout.
3. Give each group a dice and counters (or ask them to find something they can each use as a counter such as a coin).
4. The game is very simple as the students just follow the instructions on the board. However, if a student can't answer a question or gets an answer wrong, they have to go back THREE places.
5. As the students play the game, be on hand to adjudicate on any questions they may struggle with.
